Constitutional Objective



Achievements This Period


Survived COVID Lockdowns

- DCI's major revenue source, Sine Cera, significantly disrupted again due to COVID border closures. However, there are record levels of forward bookings.
- Received \$15K NSW COVID grants.

- \$30K in Family Discounts at Sine Cera










Continued growth in total donations (DCI & Projects) since 2016
