This comprehensive program has elevated football skills, improved the health and education of young players, promoted healthy living, and reducing school dropouts through various initiatives.

Nourishing Communities: Promoting Health and Preventing Illness in Rural Areas in West Java

Provided rural health services, food packages and nutrition to regional communities and promoted healthy eating, and thereby reduced illness, disease, inflammation, anemia and dehydration

Reached 153 people in the last year.



Cipanas Earthquake: Comprehensive Aid for Diverse Needs

Delivered substantial aid, impacting over 8,452 people across 2,500 households, including children, elderly, pregnant women, babies, and people with disabilities.

A multifaceted natural disaster response addressed evolving community needs, distributing relief kits, offering psychosocial support, supporting schoolchildren, repairing damaged schools, and ensuring the safety of vocational training facilities.


